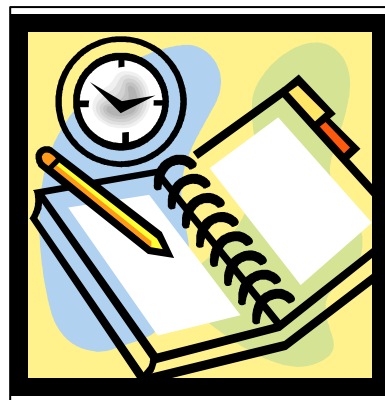
Hello Students and Parents! We hope you have been enjoying your summer vacation! Your teachers are getting the classrooms ready for the new school year and are so excited to meet you!
