COMMON DISTRICT WRITING PROMPT CATEGORIES & RUBRICS

1. **Elementary – Prompt determined by grade level PLCs & assessed with same rubrics.**
K-5th Narrative
2. **Middle – Prompt determined by grade level/dept. PLCs & assessed with same rubrics.**
6-8th Building Choice (as long as Narrative, Argument, and Informational/Research are all used as a District Writing Prompt prior to 9th grade)
3. **High – Prompt determined by grade level/dept. PLCs & assessed with same rubrics.**
9th- 11th Building Choice (as long as Narrative, Argument, and Informational/Research are all used as a District Writing Prompt prior to 12th grade)
